PRIZE MONEY.

Prize Money: First \$2, Second \$1, unless otherwise stated.

Aggregate Points: First 5 points, Second 3 points, Third 1 point.

In the event of a tie the exhibitor who has gained the most First prizes will be declared winner.

The following conditions apply to entries

Exhibits must be bona-fide grown or produced by the exhibitor.

Junior exhibits are to be grown on family farm.

Entries must be header reapt samples and not cleaned.

All produce entered must be current season.

Grain which, in the opinion of the judges, has been submitted to any process that will reduce germinating power will be disqualified.

Any entries of grain which have been pickled will be disqualified

Any grain entries contaminated with weevil will be disqualified

All exhibits must be clearly branded with Section No., Class No., and Variety.

No competitor to take more than one prize in one class with the same variety of produce.

The Society reserves the right to amend entries if they are in the wrong class.

Grain IS to be shown in clean grain bags.

Bags Of Hay to have top of bag sealed.

Entries to be recognised by and judged on Grain Receival Standards of SA
